# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The JKUATCU, after prayerful deliberations and consideration has proposed to have an annual mission in the areas between Kajiado and Namanga. The dates for the mission will be from 26<sup>th</sup> May to 2nd June. The mission ground is spread over five stations namely: Kajiado, Bulls-eye, Bisil, Mile Tisa and Namanga; all stations in Kajiado county.

As a union, part of our mission is to evangelize through outreach to the society thus the Kajiado-Namanga Mission offers us an avenue to achieve this. The main purpose of this mission is to cause a spiritual awakening unto a great revival of the people in Kajiado County. We thus intend to draw the people to our meetings as well as going to their places where they stay.

Our objective in holding this mission is to be able to engage the people of Kajiado county and evangelize to them on various fronts such as door to door evangelism, open air evangelism, evening revivals, youth seminars, community service(e.g. visiting the elderly and children homes) and sports evangelism. We aim to have 400 missionaries attending the mission.

# 1.INTRODUCTION

JKUATCU refers to Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology Christian Union. It is an inter-denominational and non-profit fellowship mainly comprising of undergraduate students of Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology **Main campus- Juja**. The union is duly registered with the university and operates under the **Chaplaincy Department** of the university, thus it is linked to the university administration through the **Chaplaincy Department**. It is also linked to other Christian unions in other universities through FOCUS-Kenya. The JKUATCU vision is to be the voice in this generation, in and out of campus, being perfect models of Godly Transformation. Our Mission is To Evangelize by influence, lifestyle and through other in reach/outreach modes, to the Church and society and to equip leaders in all areas of leadership.

## 1.1 Our objectives include:

- a) To preach Jesus Christ to others with a view of their personal commitment to Christ within and without the University.
- b) To promote maturity in the Christian faith and life among members.
- c) To encourage fellowship amongst members at a personal level.
- d) To fellowship with other Christian organizations which share similar objectives and doctrinal basis.
- e) To provide Sunday service and Children's fellowship to the University Community.

# 1. MISSIONS AND EVANGELISM IN JKUATCU

JKUATCU carries out Evangelism and Mission activities in and out of campus. Mission work and evangelism, as one of the Union's objectives is also done in keeping with **Christ's Great Commission** in Matthew 28. Every year we also go out (Annual Mission) to spread the gospel to diverse areas in Kenya, especially those that have not been widely reached by the gospel. In the past Annual Missions have been conducted in the following places:

- 2016-Mara Rianta, Narok County.
- 2014-Isinya, Kajiado County.
- 2013-Ngomeni, Kitui County.
- 2012-Mbeere, Embu County.
- 2011-Ngomeni, Kitui County.
- 2010- Mbita, Homabay County.
- 2009- Ngomeni, Kitui County.
- 2008- Marigat, Baringo County.

In addition to spreading God's Word JKUATCU conducts other community projects. In all the above annual missions, different mission activities have been carried out including Community Medical Camps(Ngomeni 2013,Marigat 2008),Farmers' Training in Tissue Culture Banana Farming(Marigat 2008) and School Construction Project(**Kasiluni Primary School,**)The school construction '**Tujenge Kasiluni**' project is ongoing and aims at providing sustainable sanitation facilities, clean drinking water and quality permanent learning classrooms at Kasiluni Primary School and lighting for Kasiluni Primary School and the surrounding Kasiluni Community in Ngomeni, Kitui County. All these are conducted in partnership with relevant bodies in the University, the Church and the government through ministries.

**2.2 Trainings** are also conducted to equip JKUATCU members in evangelism and missionary work.

## **2.3 Outcomes and Impact**

Where missionary work has been conducted in the past, there has been a notable change in the Church and Community in the area as well as on the Student Missionaries. People have become **more aware of the need for unity as Christians and the essence of prayer in our warfare as a Church.** Through community projects, the areas have also seen a lot of development. For instance, Kasiluni Primary School emerged as the best school, Ngomeni Division in KCPE 2016 with a mean score of 286 Marks. The school has also benefited the community in that the school-going kids can access education more easily. The

student missionaries also benefit from Spiritual Growth through sharing the Word, Revival meetings and participating in the projects.

## **2.4 Follow Up, Evaluation and Monitoring**

Follow up is conducted in the areas where evangelism has been carried out, both within and outside campus. It involves teaching the new believers on Studying the Word, introducing them to a Christian fellowship, offering discipleship and nurturing classes through use of guides acquired from Scripture Union, Kenya and FOCUS Kenya among others. Evaluation and monitoring is frequently conducted among all the involved parties to see the impact of the activities on each.

## **1.5 Why We Conduct Missions**

As students, we know we are called to do God's work in reaching out to others through our lifestyles, influence and other modes. Being university students we're also better placed to reach out to High School Students for mentorship and to offer Godly solutions to some of the moral issues affecting our society.

## 2. THE ANNUAL MISSION 2018

The JKUATCU Annual Mission 2018 will involve about **400** students' members of the union and associates.

### 3.1 The basic details of the Mission are:

- **Dates:** 26<sup>th</sup> May – 2<sup>nd</sup> June
- **Where:** Kajiado, Bulls-eye, Bisil, Mile Tisa and Namanga.
- **Theme:** No other foundation other than Jesus Christ.(1 Corinthians 3:11)
- **Cost and Charges:** In total, the Mission will cost approximately **Kshs. 986,618**, with each student missionary expected to raise **Kshs. 2300**. The Christian Union is fundraising for the balance.
- **Mission Stations:** Are **5** in number, these are: **Kajiado** (Main Station) **Bulls-eye, Bisil, Mile Tisa and Namanga**.
- **Overall Goal:** The Mission seeks to spread God's word to the society so that many may believe and come to the saving Grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

### 3.2 Background Information

The current society, including the Kajiado community is faced with the challenge of increasing atheism, false doctrines and disunity in church and moral decadence among others. From a meeting held between JKUATCU and Pastors in the area, it was found that between Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup>-Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2018 following issues are prevalent in this area:

#### a). **Strongholds**

- i. Witchcraft.
- ii. False doctrine.
- iii. Drug abuse and drunkenness
- iv. Men not going to church
- v. Sexual immorality.
- vi. Prostitution

#### b). **Challenges.**

- i. Early marriages.
- ii. School dropout.
- iii. Poverty.
- iv. Reaching out to the Islamic community
- v. Social amenities.

It is for the above stated reasons that a Christian community in campus sees the need to fulfill the Great Commission in this region. We also hope to set an example in the region that Higher Education is achievable and refute the assumption that Christianity and **Morality cannot thrive in campus**.

### **3.3 Specific Objectives of the Mission**

- a) To provide a platform for the student missionaries to share God's Word, to offer mentorship and to grow together through sharing, Bible Studies and revival meetings.
- b) To encourage the Church in the area, addressing the societal issues listed above.
- c) To teach sound doctrine through Discipleship and follow up
- d) To set an example to the believers in everything through follow up and activities conducted during the mission week.
- e) To offer mentorship and encouragement to students that they may see the possibility of joining tertiary institutions.
- f) To address, in conjunction with the church, the harmful cultural practices.

### **3.4 Anticipated Outcome**

- a) A united church having a stable pastor's fellowship.
- b) A community motivated towards education.
- c) A church that preaches sound doctrine.
- d) A community that understands negative effects of some practices such witchcraft and early marriages.
